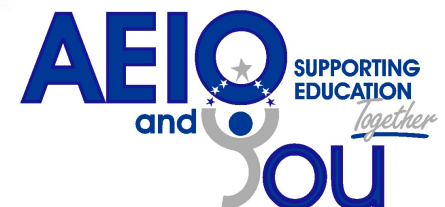

PA Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program



Businesses that qualify for the Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) Program may be eligible for tax credits up to 90% of their contributions made to a qualified Educational Improvement Organization (EIO) such as AEIO. Deadline for a new EITC application is July 1st.
